

General and Vocal Music

Students in 5th grade general music study a variety of musical topics such as:

- Styles and genre
- Composers
- Musical forms
- Various vocal selections
- Movement
- Music and how it relates to other subjects (art, history, literature, etc.)

All 5th grade students participate in this general music class.

Information is structured to follow the National Standards of Music Education.

6th Grade Chorus - Full year elective course.

This developing vocal ensemble rehearses daily. Chorus members will study a variety of musical styles, elements and vocal compositions. Our studies will include;

- Tonality
- Unison and 2-part singing
- Vocal expression
- Musical movement

Students will perform in a Fall Concert, Winter Concert, Music Advocates fundraiser, Spring Concert and Graduation.

7th & 8th Grade Concert Choir - Full year elective course.

This concert vocal ensemble rehearses daily. Chorus members will study a variety of musical styles, elements and vocal compositions. Our studies will include;

- Tonality
- Unison and 2-part and 3-part singing, small group vocal ensembles and solo singing
- Vocal expression
- Musical movement

Students will perform in a Fall Concert, Winter Concert, Music Advocates fundraiser, Local music festival, Spring Concert and Graduation.

School Musical

This bi-annual event is open to all 6th, 7th and 8th grade students. All students who audition will be given a place in the musical. There are also opportunities for stage personnel, running crew and a variety of other back stage positions. Auditions are held in mid-winter with the performances taking place in late April/early May.
